**Dr. Hiroyuki Mori** is a professor at the College of Policy Science in Ritsumeikan University, Kyoto, Japan and a visiting professor at Cornell University. He is a public finance researcher who has been interested in public works and intergovernmental fiscal relations. *Public Works Reforms* (2008) reflects his early concern with Japan's infrastructure issues from regional socio-economic perspectives. This book was prized from an academic society Japan Association of Local Public Finance in 2009. He has energetically published a lot of articles in public finance fields. He has been recently engaged in asbestos disaster problems concerning both labor and environmental issues. He is a co-editor of *Asbestos Disaster: Lessons from Japan's Experience* (2011), the first book on Japan's asbestos problems in English. He has served for the board of directors in academic societies in Japan.
